MONTHLY

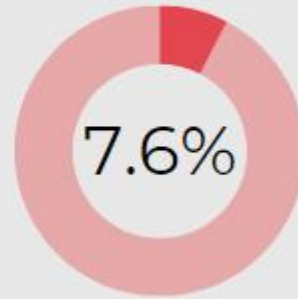
PAPAC has a goal to gain 25 new reoccurring donations each month. **In the month of May we had ZERO new reoccurring monthly donations set up.**
